- Fostering development in English/Language arts, social studies, physical education, and social-emotional learning






















CORE VALUES: F.D.R.

- Being a good example for others


Discipline to:

Afro Brazil Arts Story

In 1988, following a year living and practicing capoeira in Bahia, Brazil, I was contracted as a Board of Education (now DOE) licensed teacher to teach capoeira full time at University Heights and Bronx Regional, two public high schools in the South Bronx.

Together with June Mapp, a dancer and educator, Afro Brazil Arts was founded in 1991 as a nonprofit organization to bring Mindful Capoeira and related African and Afro Brazilian culture, dance, and music to youth with a focus on providing performances and classes in under served schools and communities.

Afro Brazil Arts has since introduced generations of youths to Mindful Capoeira. Our team of performing and teaching artists have pioneered capoeira school programs serving grades K-12, special needs populations, children's hospitals and in centers for incarcerated youth. Afro Brazil Arts Mindful Capoeira Academy in a School Program is a culmination of over 30 years teaching capoeira in schools and in our academy, the New York Mindful Capoeira Center.


